



Lusa - Business News - Angola: Investment, export agency looking to boost cooperation with France

Luanda, Nov. 14, 2025 (Lusa) - The Angolan Investment and Export Promotion Agency (Aipex) will send a technical delegation to France to promote exports and attract investment, in a mission organised with Business France and supported by the European Union.

The visit will take place over 17 to 21 November and will involve working sessions with Business France, the French public agency responsible for the internationalisation of companies, investment prospecting and business expansion support, according to a statement from the two entities.

The mission aims to expose Angolan executives to European practices in investor monitoring, opportunity identification and specialised sector promotion.

The programme includes meetings at Business France's headquarters in Paris, participation in the Ambition Africa 2025 event - which brings together African and European entrepreneurs and decision-makers annually - and technical visits to Marseille and the Rungis international market, Europe's largest centre for fresh agri-food products.

The initiative is part of the EU-Angola Dialogues programme, funded by the European Union, and focuses on the agro-industrial sector, which Angola considers a priority for diversifying exports and attracting foreign capital.
